

Christian Youth Director Position

10 hours per week (with potential expansion as the program grows)
\$10-15 per hour (depending on experience)

The youth director position would be to develop a youth program for Grace Lutheran Church. This program would primarily be aimed at junior high and high school youth and involve three components: spiritual time, community outreach and fellowship or “fun time” as outlined below.

1. The youth director would be expected to see to the implementation of a spiritual reflection/gathering time at least once per week. This time would involve small group meetings of the youth to reflect on Christian teachings and principles. Since the Grace Lutheran is part of the Evangelical Lutheran Church which is a mainline Christian denomination, the youth director would be expected to uphold the teachings of this body.
2. The director would also work on engaging the church youth in community outreach/community service projects that will work to deepen their commitment to Christian ideals.
3. The director would work to establish fellowship activities—with a goal of once per month activities, but possibly beginning with activities at least 4 times per year.

Additional responsibilities

The youth director would be required to meet with the **Education Committee** at their monthly Education meeting to help establish a program in cooperation with the activities/goals of youth education.

The youth director would be directly under the supervision of the **pastor** and would meet at least once a week with the pastor to establish direction.

The youth director would be expected to attend services at Grace on a regular basis in order to set a good example for and establish contact with our youth.

The youth director would make an effort to establish contacts in the community in order to make the program known to and available to as many youth as possible within the community.

Selection:

The youth director will submit a resume and at least one letter of recommendation.

The youth director will be interviewed by a committee made up of:

At least one representative from the education committee

At least one representative from the council
